# Volunteer Monitor Program Report

The Volunteer Monitor (VM) Program is a joint initiative between ARRL and the FCC to enhance compliance in the Amateur Radio Service. This is the July 2025 activity report of the VM Program.

Technician operators in Florida and Georgia received advisories concerning 17-meter FT8 operation, a band on which Technicians have no privileges.

Technician operators in Florida, California, and Oregon received advisory notices concerning 20-meter FT8 operation, a band on which Technicians have no privileges.

A commendation was issued to an operator in Ohio for exceptional work with the April 29, 2025, SKYWARN® net on the Preble County 145.470 MHz repeater.

There was one virtual club presentation about the Volunteer Monitor Program.

The totals for June 2025 monitoring were 1,208 hours on HF frequencies, and 1,668 hours on VHF frequencies and above, for a total of 2,876 hours.
